Shan-Chieh Chien is Co-President of UMC (United Microelectronics Corp.).

Chien has more than 30 years of R&D experience in semiconductor area. He joined UMC since 1989, mainly worked in technology development. He is the author of 21 publications and holds 176 worldwide patents. He granted 2001 National R&D Manager Excellence Award issued by CPMA. He also granted 1998 National Innovation Award issued by MOEA.

During his over 28 years' career in UMC, he worked in different jobs: ATD (advanced tech development), STD (specialty tech development), CE (customer engineering), TTD (technology transfer and development), IPDS (IP & design support) and CM (Corporate marketing). Technology development covers SRAM, DRAM, eDRAM, Advanced Logic, MM/RF, eHV, eNVM, BCD, CIS and MEMS.
